

Sanskrit Letters from Kashmir in the Private Archive of Johannes Hertel

The voluminous private archive of Johannes Hertel in the Leipzig University Library contains *inter alia* letters and postcards of several Paṇḍits from India. Among them is the correspondence in Sanskrit with the Kashmirian Paṇḍit Sahajabhaṭṭa, who was supporting Hertel in his *Pañcatantra* studies. This paper aims at providing an insight in this correspondence and in the way of cooperation between Hertel and Sahajabhaṭṭa at the beginning of the 20th century.
